

# **Articles of Association**

## **Article I: Name**

The name of the association is The Elodrym.

## **Article II: Association**

The association is an unincorporated non-profit educational religious organization.

## **Article III: Duration**

The period of duration of the association is perpetual.

## **Article IV: Registered Agent and Office**

The name of the President and street address of the association's headquarters in California is Michael R. Miller 124 Towhee Dr. Bonny Doon, California 95060.

## **Article V: Purpose**

The association is organized exclusively for religious, educational, and charitable purposes by offering worship services and religious education classes, and to do any and all things which may be necessary or proper in connection with these purposes. In furtherance of its permitted purposes, the association may exercise any, all, and every power that an association organized under the Unincorporated Association Law of California may do.

## **Article VI: Effective Date**

The effective date of this document is the date it is filed with the Secretary of State of California.

## **Article VII: Members and Organizational Structure**

Participation and membership in the association shall be designated within its bylaws.

## **Article IIX: Directors**

The affairs of the association shall be managed by its President and Vice President. The initial President shall be Michael R. Miller 124 Towhee Dr. Bonny Doon, California 95060. The terms and successor to the President may be adjusted from time to time as provided in the Bylaws of the association.

## Article IX: Stock and Payment

The association shall not issue stock. The association shall be authorized and empowered to pay, for services rendered, reasonable compensation to the leadership, membership, volunteers, or other outside parties and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes.

## Article X: Assets

All property, purchased, produced, or gifted shall be the property of the Association. In the event the Association ceases to exist, all funds, property, and assets will be assigned, at the discretion of the President, to either a similar organization or divided among members.
